

## **Curriculum Vitae**

**Thomas Langheinrich** was born in Berlin, Germany, and raised in Karlsruhe. He received a law degree from the Albert-Ludwigs-Universität Freiburg, Law School. He was a Fulbright Scholar at the Lyndon B. Johnson Graduate School of Public Affairs - University of Texas, Austin, USA.

He served as Managing Director of the Department of Commerce and Infrastructural Planning in the Baden-Württemberg State administration. Before that, he was Deputy Spokesman of the government of Baden-Württemberg. He also served as Senior Policy Advisor in different agencies of the State.

Since 1<sup>st</sup> April 2005 he is the elected President of the Media Broadcasting Authority of the State of Baden-Württemberg, Germany (Landesanstalt für Kommunikation, LFK). Currently he is the Commissioner of European Affairs of the Directors' Conference of the German Regulatory Authorities for Broadcasting (DLM). He is also a member of the German Commission for the Protection of Minors in the Media (KJM) and the German Commission on Concentration in the Media (KEK). He also serves on the Board of Directors of the Media Competence Forum Southwest (MKFS). Since 2014 he is the German Delegate at the European Regulators Group for Audiovisual Media Services (ERGA) established by the European Commission.
